

## Case Management Program Estimate Fee Sheet - \$6,500 Discount

The Case Management is for Intended Parents who recruit their own gestational surrogate(s) but have not yet started the screening process. Once you introduce your chosen surrogate to AFS and she signs our Agency Agreement, this program includes everything our Full-Service Program provides. This includes everything you'll need for a successful surrogacy journey, including: a dedicated Coordinator at AFS for the Gestational Carrier and the Intended Parents, locating and fully screening outstanding Gestational Carriers, facilitating match meetings, coordinating psychological evaluations, coordinating with legal counsel, clinics and other industry professionals, postpartum support for Gestational Carriers and Parents, and support of you and your Gestational Carrier every step of the way.

### **Non-Medical Screening Fee (non-refundable)**

This fee is paid directly to All Families Surrogacy. It is applied against screening costs for indepth screening of Gestational Carrier and Partner, completed prior to matching. Includes, but not limited to, background check(s), psychological evaluation, home visit (by request), obtaining medical records, coordinating with clinic for GC approval, and coordination of match meeting(s). Also includes criminal background check(s) of Intended Parent(s).

### **Trust Account Management Fee**

The escrow agent charges a flat fee for the duration of your surrogacy contract. Escrow and AFS will work together to process all payments and reimbursements to your Gestational Carrier. You will have 24/7 online access to this account.

### **Gestational Carrier Fees (compensation package)**

Gestational carrier fees are always held in a third-party escrow account.

Baseline compensation for a 1st time surrogate paid in equal monthly installments after ultrasound confirmation of pregnancy, all states. This includes payment for a positive pregnancy test and payment for heartbeat confirmation.	\$40,000 - \$45,000

### **Supplemental Wellness and Family Benefits Package**

The Gestational Carrier shall receive a variety of supplemental family benefits such as: date nights, family movie and/or dinner nights, and/or wellness packages (i.e. pregnancy massages, acupuncture, chiropractor, doula, et al). Gestational Carrier will receive benefits up to this entire amount. Intended Parent(s), at any time throughout the journey, may use funds from this benefit package to have All Families Surrogacy send specific requested gifts on their behalf.

# **Legal Fees**

Intended Parent(s) are responsible for their attorney fees, as well as those of the Gestational Carrier. All outside legal fees are estimates only, based on industry standards.

# **Surrogate Medical/Insurance Costs**

Health Insurance: Intended Parent(s) are responsible for all pregnancy, prenatal and delivery related medical fees not covered by insurance, such as copays, deductibles, coinsurance and in most cases, monthly premiums. The amount of insurance costs will vary depending on the insurance policy and medical circumstances.	\$9,000- \$20,000*
Insurance Review & Policy Initiation (per Calendar Year): Intended Parent(s) are responsible for all fees associated with insurance reviews with license brokers and policy initiation done by insurance broker.	\$700
Billing Management: Intended Parent(s) are responsible for fees associated with insurance broker pre & post birth claims management. The insurance broker will support All Families Surrogacy in managing medical bills with the surrogate's medical providers for the pregnancy, delivery and postpartum period.	\$1,750
Life Flight Emergency Air Evacuation: Intended Parent(s) are responsible for fees associated with Life Flight. This is an additional insurance policy for the states of Oregon, Washington, and Idaho. This is a onetime fee that covers a surrogate if needed to be air lifted.	\$100



Life Insurance (Accidental Death): Intended Parent(s) are responsible for fees associated with Life Insurance.

### **Variable Expenses**

All Families Surrogacy requires a \$20,000 Variable Expenses Deposit into escrow for variable expenses, due upon confirmation of heartbeat via ultrasound. This deposit is fully refundable approximately three to six months after the conclusion of your surrogacy journey, minus any required variable expenses paid out. Below is a list of variable costs. Some are paid from variable cost deposit, and some are prepaid in escrow installment 2.

Fetal reduction before 13th week	\$1,000
Fetal reduction/termination after 13th week or labor induction due to no heartbeat or abnormalities	\$2,000
Invasive procedure compensation - per occurrence (D&C, CVS, cerclage, etc.)	\$1,000
Ectopic pregnancy surgery	\$1,000
Loss of uterus / hysterectomy	\$5,000
Loss of ovaries or fallopian tubes (per each)	\$1,000
Dropped or Mock Cycle	\$500
Cesarean section	\$3,000
Counseling for Gestational Carrier	\$1,200
Birth and/or Postpartum Doula	\$1,000-\$2,000

#### **Other Additional Fees:**

### IVF / Egg Donor / Clinic Medical Fees: \$20,000 -\$50,000

All costs associated with the IVF procedures, egg donors or IVF Centers, including but not limited to medical testing, screening, laboratory, medications, ultrasounds, and doctor visits (whether for Intended Parent(s), Egg/Sperm Donor or Gestational Carrier) are in addition to this fee structure and will be paid directly to your doctor and/or clinic. Please contact your clinic for a complete listing of additional costs. We will be happy to assist you in obtaining your clinic's fees for your Gestational Carrier's medical appointments and procedures, as well as referring you to an Egg/Sperm Donor agency.

#### **International Newborn Insurance: \$10,000-\$120,000**

Also, not included in the above estimated fee is Newborn Insurance. Newborn policies are cost containment programs that coordinate provider negotiations and payments of newborn medical expenses incurred from the delivery, in-patient services in the hospital, and potentially outpatient needs following discharge from the hospital. Plans are professionally managed, providing protection from high newborn care costs due to complications.
